Jack Buck (Farms) Ltd is a 4th generation medium sized family business located in Moulton Seas End, farming 1800 acres of Grade 1 silt. Cropping revolves around speciality vegetables and root crops such as Celeriac, Fennel. Their celeriac brand "The Ugly One" is a familiar sight in the UK market place. The cropping programme also includes Wheat, Potatoes, Daffodils, Peas, Sugar Beet and Onions, marketing to retailers, wholesalers and processors.

The company is described as a 'pro-active, environmentally conscious and well-invested farm business, keen to take up new challenges.'
